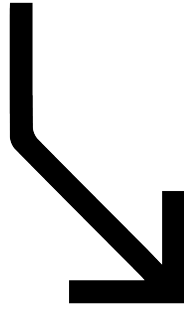
I WANT TO LEAVE THIS EARTH BEHIND — immersive performance

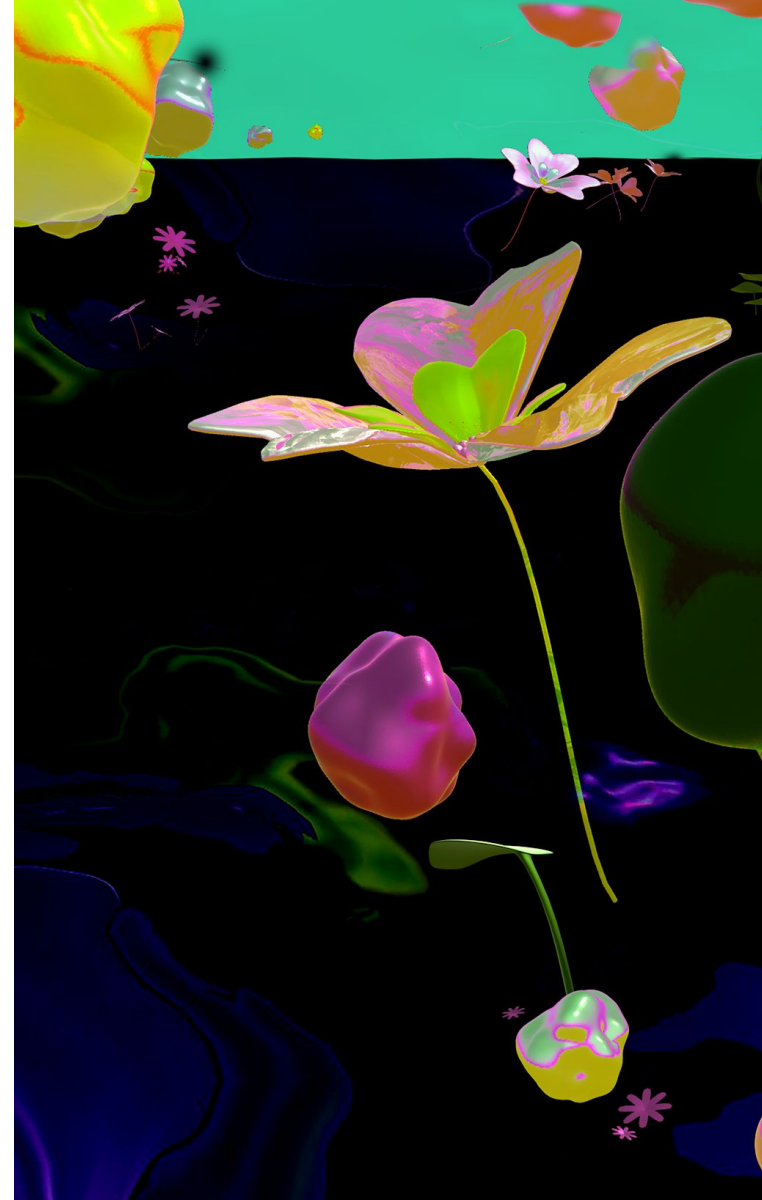
Stefana Fratila
